

COVID-19 Impact at St. Mary's


2019-2020 - St. Mary's moved to distance learning on March 4, 2020 and finished the school year entirely online.

2020-2021 - St. Mary's returned to face-to-face instruction with many canceled or modified extracurricular activities.


2021-2022 - St. Mary's returned fully face-to-face instruction and slowly reintroduced extra curriculars.

Due to the impact of COVID-19, our students have had less access to SAT/SAT Subject and ACT tests because of cancellations, few dates and sites offering the exams.



St. Mary's prides itself on being non-exclusive when it comes to IB courses; we encourage all students who meet set academic requirements to take on the challenge. All high school students are enrolled in IB classes and more than 85% of current grade 11 and 12 students are full IB diploma candidates. Students take three HL and three SL classes as recommended by the IBO. All students who take IB courses must sit for the exams.
