Head of School

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St. Mary's International School is a Catholic international all-boys school that has been providing quality education in the Tokyo area for 67 years. Our international student body, rich in cultural and religious diversity, contributes to a unique and vibrant educational experience. Many of our students carry two or more passports and speak English and at least one other language. Every student graduates with a St. Mary's High School Diploma and can also earn the International Baccalaureate Diploma. St. Mary's students attend school for two semesters per year, beginning in August and concluding early in June.

St. Mary's complies with NACAC and Common Application guidelines on reporting students' disciplinary violations.

Starting the 2022-23 school year, we have implemented a 12 university application limit worldwide.

Activities at St. Mary's

St. Mary's students are exceptionally active in the Fine Arts and various activities. With more than 25 programs in which to choose, over 90% of HS student body take part in curricular and extra-curricular fine arts classes and activities. Included are ensembles, clubs, and teams which encompass art, music, drama, debate, brain bowl, speech, film, design, and MUN, to name a few.

Music

St. Mary's Fine Arts program is second to none with over half the student body taking part. The choirs and bands are known locally and worldwide, winning numerous awards and invitations to perform.

Athletics

St. Mary's students are encouraged to participate on athletic teams. We are a member of the Kanto Plain Athletics Conference, which includes the Department of Defense Activity Education schools (DoDEA) and local international schools (KPASS).

Service at St. Mary's

We have multiple service clubs at St. Mary's, ranging from Green Club to Humanity Outreach Charity. Fukushima Benefactors is a service club at St. Mary's that supports the survivors of the 2011 Tohoku earthquake and tsunami.

COVID-19 Impact at St. Mary's

2019-2020 – St. Mary's moved to distance learning on March 4, 2020 and finished the school year entirely online.

2020-2021 – St. Mary's returned to face-to-face instruction with many canceled or modified extracurricular activities.

2021-2022 – St. Mary's returned fully face-to-face instruction and slowly reintroduced extra curriculars.

2022-2023 – St. Mary's is continuing fully face-to-face instruction and almost all extra curricular activities are running.

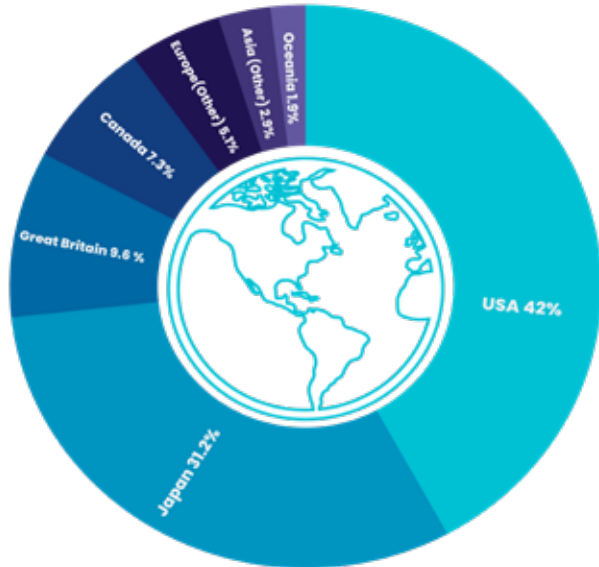
High School Population

Due to the impact of COVID-19, our students have had less access to SAT/SAT Subject and ACT tests because of cancellations, few dates and sites offering the exams.

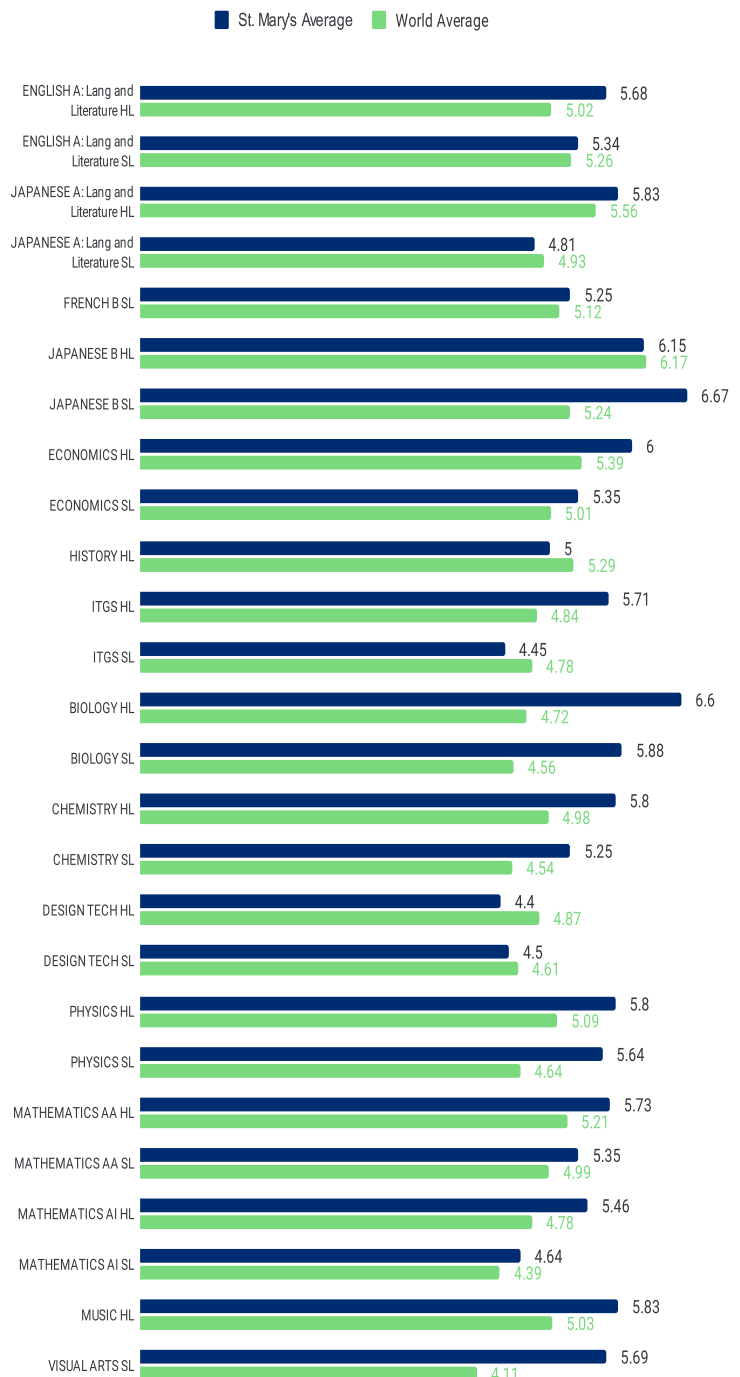

IB Diploma Programme

St. Mary's prides itself on being non-exclusive when it comes to IB courses; we encourage all students who meet set academic requirements to take on the challenge. All high school students are enrolled in IB classes and more than 85% of current grade 11 and 12 students are full IB diploma candidates. Students take three HL and three SL classes as recommended by the IBO. All students who take IB courses must sit for the exams.

Graduation Requirements

The minimum number of credits required to earn a diploma from St. Mary's High School is 27. Each year long course (2 semesters) has a credit value of 1.0 and semester long courses have a 0.5 credit value.
